

STUDENT CONDUCT PATHWAYS

HOW DOES SAGE DETERMINE NEXT STEPS FOR A CASE?

SAGE receives case and determines proper conduct pathway

PATH A:

Advisory Notice

No record or appeal. Students receive non-disciplinary communication. e.g. Notice of Informal Warnings

PATH B:

Alternative Resolution

Voluntary and Non-disciplinary: Students complete assigned AR agreements. e.g. MAP cases and Mediated Dialogues, Restorative justice

PATH C:

Administrative Resolution Meeting

Student Conduct Administrators review the case and determine the student is responsible for violating University policy. Conduct Administrators then apply the **SANCTIONING FRAMEWORK**

What is an Administrative Resolution Meeting (ARM)?

A meeting between you and a Student Conduct Officer to discuss one or more alleged violations of the Student Conduct Procedures, or other university policies and procedures.
